15 Gently open the metal case. This is easiest if the console is upright. In short, your Xbox One controller needs looking after. This is the cable that attaches the Wi-Fi card to the console's circuitry. Slide this left until it pulls away from the console. Two of the screws are at the bottom of the fan box. But what can you do next? Do not pull the casing off of the console yet. Insert a flathead screwdriver or spudger into the space between the back-left corner of the console and the plastic grille on the left side of the console, then gently pry the grille away from the console. From hygiene steps to manage infection control to keeping the Xbox One controller buttons responsive, cleaning is important. Find the front of the cable, which will be near the "On" button for the console's face plate. The casing bracket is on the far-right side of the grille area. Put the screws aside safely for later. The back panel should now simply lift off. To do this, you need to know how to take apart the Xbox One controller, clean it, repair it, and reassemble it. You can now lift out the main controller. Pull the card straight up from underneath. This will disconnect the cable from the top of the casing. Set the metal case aside with the cable side facing up. Make sure the Xbox One is sitting flat with its bottom face-down when you do this. Be aware that a further teardown will expose electrical components. 1. Once reassembled, use disinfectant wipes to deal with infection risks. This will unplug the Wi-Fi card from the Xbox One's internal circuit board. Unresponsive buttons can be checked (often fixed with additional cleaning) and thumbsticks repaired. It's on the far-left side of the grille area. The metal case is the last piece of the Xbox One that you need to remove in order to open it. These can be de-soldered with care, but this is only really necessary if you're stripping it down for replacement components. Using the plectrum or spudger, detach the plastic panels on the back of the controller's "handles" where the controller sits in your hand. You can't use standard screwdrivers to get inside an Xbox One controller. Here are some ways you might continue. There should be two wires connecting the top of the console to the front of the console; unplug these from the front of the console by gently pulling on them. If you have a small vacuum cleaner, suitable for electronics, use this to collect any loose dirt that falls out of reach. Place it on a table or similar hard surface with the tools within easy reach. Use a Torx T8 screwdriver to do this. Make sure you place the discarded screws in a plastic bag so that you don't lose them. You should be able to do this without any resistance, since all of the connectors are now unhooked. This will completely detach the top of the metal case from the Xbox One. 5 Slide the casing bracket off of the console. Remove the door to the battery compartment and set it aside. How to Take Apart a Microsoft Xbox One Controller The process for opening the Xbox One controller is straightforward with the right tools. The Wi-Fi card is in the lower-left corner of the Xbox One's casing if the front of the Xbox One is facing you. As a result, it needs to be regularly maintained. Once all of the brackets are unhooked, the back part of the Xbox One's casing will pop open. If not, consider buying a replacement controller, or looking at other troubleshooting steps. 13 Remove the Wi-Fi card. Breaking the warranty sticker will officially void your warranty. There are eight total screws to remove; you'll see a light "C" with a number next to or below the screws. Clean Your Xbox One Controller Keeping your controller clean is highly recommended, whatever the circumstances. We put the Xbox One controller through a lot. Gently tug the cable's connector, which is white, away from the off-white port into which it's plugged. In most cases this problem can be resolved by gluing a small pole of metal--perhaps from a thumbtack--into the thumbstick itself and pushing this into the analogue controller mounted on the circuit board. If you want to remove a stuck CD from your Xbox One's disk drive, there should be a pinhole in the front of the Xbox One's face plate where you can insert a small item (e.g., a paperclip) to force the drive to open. Once you find it, pull the blue tab that's wrapped around the connector up, then gently tug the cable to the left. The Xbox One controller is prone to thumbsticks (joysticks) coming loose. Congratulations--you've successfully taken apart your Xbox One controller. Most cleaning will take place around the plastic components. 3. Worry not--various Xbox One controller tool kits can be bought online. Consider a full teardown, stripping the device down to just the PCBs. You might even take this a step further and detach the triggers, thumbsticks, buttons, and more. The PCBs, meanwhile, can be detached from the interior plastic chassis by removing four small screws. Xbox Series X Controller Keeps Disconnecting? To unhook this bracket: pull on the bottom of the bracket while pushing on the top of the bracket, then insert a flathead screwdriver into the seam that's covered by the warranty sticker on the back of the console and pry until the bracket unhooks. Your Xbox One should be completely free of any wires or attachments, including external storage, HDMI/audio cables, and the charging cable. Compatible with several devices (particularly PCs) as well as the Xbox One, this controller gets banged, dropped, and grimy. Doing so will break the ribbon that connects the front of your Xbox One to the circuit board. It helps to use a plastic tool rather than a metal tool here, since the grille is made of relatively delicate plastic. Then there's issues with the feedback motors, buttons, and thumb sticks. However, more striking customizations to your controller's appearance can be made with a can of paint and adhesion promoter. You now have your Xbox One controller in pieces on your surface. Remove the batteries, saving them for later. Hold the fan corner of the case and pry it up diagonally so that the cable in the adjacent corner isn't damaged.[2] Don't force this step. Notice how this is a secondary plastic case, which houses a pair of PCBs (printed circuit boards). At this stage you can now replace thumbsticks, D-pad, and the other buttons if you're planning on some customizations. Going further, four thin wires can be found on the left and right side of the controller (eight wires in total). You should be able to see the fan, the hard drive, and the CD drive, as well as the green motherboard along the bottom of the console. Repair the Xbox One Controller Thumbstick Various repairs can be performed once the Xbox One controller is open. Further disassembly at this stage requires some electronics knowledge so don't proceed if you're inexperienced with PCBs and electrical components (see below). If you have a third-party Xbox One controller, these typically feature eight screws than can be removed with a small Philips screwdriver. How to Open the Xbox One or Xbox Series X/S Controller Before proceeding, ensure your Xbox One controller is powered off. Third-party Xbox One controller Having said that, you can use this guide to open a first generation Xbox Series X/S controller. You'll find two on the left, two on the right, and another beneath the label in the battery compartment. Set the Wi-Fi card aside in the same place as the top of the Xbox One's casing. This can take a while, so take your time patiently wiggling the plectrum along each edge to unclip them. With the controller face down, unscrew the five Torx screws. Follow these steps to open the Xbox One controller. What You Will Need to Disassemble Your Xbox One Controller Opening an Xbox One controller isn't as easy as cracking open an old radio. The top of the casing should swing up and over, coming to rest at a 90 degree angle to the console's body. Insert your screwdriver into the top section of the grille that's on the back of the console and twist it until the bracket unhooks, then repeat this process all the way down the side of the console. Microsoft recommends isopropyl alcohol for cleaning dirt; use cotton swabs to clean difficult to reach areas. 14 Remove the screws from the metal case. Note that these steps are specifically for Microsoft-produced Xbox One and Xbox One S controllers rather than later or third party devices.
